





NUMBER OF HROMADAS WHICH HAVE AMALGAMATED OR ACCESSED ALREADY EXISTING AH OR COS











Average number of hromadas amalgamated into one AH




Average population of one AH (persons)



Local budget own revenue (general fund) share in GDP, %




Local budget general fund own revenue, bln. UAH.










Growth rate of local budgets general fund revenue per capita for January- April 2016-2019, % and UAH

2019 compared to January-April 2018 (according to budget levels), in % and bln. UAH



















