



NUMBER OF AMALGAMATED HROMADAS










Average number of hromadas , which amalgamated into one AH




















**Growth rate of local budgets general fund revenue

Share of local taxes and fees in the local budgets own revenues (general fund), %




Growth rate of local taxes and fees in local budgets in January – September 2019 compared to January-September 2018 (according to budget levels), in% and bln. UAH






Remaining balance of local budgets in Ukraine, 2019










